Set-up Friday night, evening registration begins at 4PM to 9PM. Staff will be available to help shuttle gear to your camp site. No vehicles will be allowed in camp. Due to safety no arrivals will be allowed after 9pm. **CAMP IS DARK, BRING YOUR FLASHLIGHT!** Eat before you come to camp or bring your evening meal with you. You are also responsible for Saturday breakfast.

Saturday arrival check in is between 7 to 745 AM. Program starts at 8AM. Staff will be available to assist a Pack leader with shuttling camp gear to your camp site. You may designate an adult leader to set up camp or the Pack may set up after supper.

Please indicate on Registration form what nights your Pack is camping. Units not camping will be dismissed after campfire program Saturday evening.

Camping patch: youth in the units that are camping with receive a special patch in addition to the event patch.

MEALS: we want to provide a great camp K experience for our participants. We will be serving lunch and supper on Saturday. For those camping overnight Saturday we will be serving breakfast on Sunday

**UNIT LEADERS NOTE**

- Units are responsible for having the unit roster of adults and youth as well as medical forms, emergency contact info, and medication forms. Please designate an adult leader to hold all the documents so they can be obtained in the event of an emergency.

Suggested Personal Equipment – our event is rain or shine! Be prepared.

Please consider the following suggestions

**UNITS CAMPING**

- Flashlight or headlamp
- Sleeping bag or several blankets
- Pillow
- Changes of clothes
- Poncho or rain suit
- Personal first aid kit
- Personal hygiene items
- Personal medication
- Day pack or string bag
- Scout uniform (you bought one why not wear it!!!)

Camp facilities will be open for camper use. Shower house and flush toilets are available.

NOTE: campsites with tents, cots, dining fly and picnic table will be assigned to campers. Units may be asked to share a campsite depending on the size of your group. if you wish to bring your own tent you may do so. Please remember the amount of time it takes to set up your tent especially if you are doing so after dark or early Saturday morning.

### Campfires

Camp sites have a fire pit and units camping are welcome to build fires Friday or Saturday evening. Bring your own wood cutting tools. No cutting of live or standing trees is permitted. (it doesn't burn anyway) there is plenty of wood on the ground to gather for your campfire. Liquid fuels or accelerants are not permitted in camp.

**Please fill in the registration form completely.** This will help us know who is camping and who is only coming for the day. It will also help in assigning of camp sites. Electric sites are for medical use only such as C Pap machines. Please indicate on your registration if you require electric. This is on a first come first served basis.

Due to supply requirements, rotation scheduling, staffing, and patch orders we must have a deadline for registration. No late registrations will be accepted. Thank you for your understanding

**Please provide an email for the person who is in charge and coming to the event we will be sending more information that will make your event even more enjoyable. Event schedules and other information will be sent out prior to the camporee.**

### **Vehicles**

**Vehicles are not allowed in camp. Please carpool and consolidate gear as much as possible. Staff will be assisting campers with their camping gear and guiding you to your campsite.**
